<u>Overview of Clackamas County Pretrial Services:</u> Eric Anderson provided an overview of the Clackamas County Pretrial program since inception 2/5/18. See attached power point presentation.

Governor's Public Safety Taskforce Update: Bridget Budbill provided an update on behalf of the Criminal Justice Commission. The Taskforce will begin meeting again in January 2020 and will meet once a month thereafter. She hopes they will have a recommendation for the legislature regarding potential new pretrial legislation or policy recommendations for the 2021 session. The delay since April has been primarily due to the complications in trying to find statewide pretrial jail data and appearance rates. However, some strides in this data collection has been made. The Governor's office is showing a great deal of interest in pretrial, which is a good sign in terms of support of pretrial efforts statewide.
