- Reminder: Many requests to add prior victims from past cases: More information as to why it is necessary: present safety risk, ongoing contact (SC11)
- Cortez case: violation for possession of weapon: intent to use as a weapon needs to be there. Include detail, context: will revisit definition.

**Training:**

Det. Jodi Libertad: Clatsop county: Interviewing survivors of Domestic Violence:

- ORS: 163.187: Legal definition of strangulation
  - Strangulation/Suffocation/ Choking Questionnaire.
  - Understanding trauma/stress and impacts on memory & reasoning
  - Interview tactics: FETI: Forensic Experimental Trauma Interview: science informed interviewing to maximizes opportunities for accurate information collection

**Updates: DOC: Jon Hanson:**

- Overrides: Most counties don't have written override policies and many times most are only to override up.
- Request to work on recommendation for best practices: overrides: considering treatment completions, compliance etc.
- MRNA: current pilot w/ DOC & OACCD.
- PSC: working on updates: new PSC will be based on 127 points of data.
  - Testing: appears to be more predictive: possibly more sensitive to Assaults
  - Timeline: Webinars in April to explain: will possibly go live in July
